### SEAL No. TWO

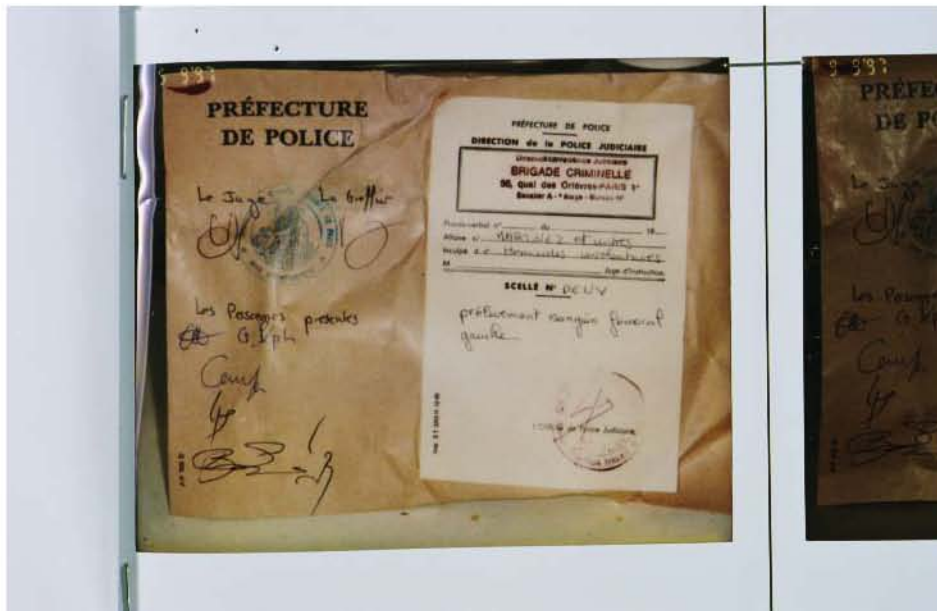
This is a brown envelope containing a plastic bottle sealed with wax seals, with the slip stuck to the envelope and bearing the following inscriptions:
