

for FAILING TO RENDER ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS IN DANGER, MANSLAUGHTER, UNINTENTIONAL INJURY LEADING TO A TOTAL INCAPACITY FOR WORK OF OVER THREE MONTHS, offences provided for and punishable under Articles 223-6(2), 221-6(1) and (2), 221-19 of the Penal Code

Having regard to Article 156 ff. of the Code of Criminal Procedure;

Whereas it is appropriate to appoint in addition to the first registered expert Mrs Véronique Dumestre Toulle, a specialist able to provide assistance to the expert

I instruct Mr Gilbert Pépin, [REDACTED], an expert registered on the list of the Court of Cassation

and Mrs Véronique Dumestre Toulle, resident at [REDACTED], a non-registered expert, whom I am requiring to be sworn, appointed on the grounds of her specifically recognised expertise in view of the specific nature of the assignment;

State that, having examined the file, the experts will provide a detailed report containing their reasoned opinion and a declaration that they have personally carried out the task assigned to them before 20 September 1997;

To analyse the blood sample taken from the body of Henri Paul in my presence on 4 September 1997 in order to determine alcohol consumption habits by measuring deglycosile transferrin/beta globulin.
