H R H The Princess of Wales

HRH The Princess of Wales will not in future be accompanied by a protection officer from SO14 Branch, save on 'official' occasions.

Telephone calls may be received by SO15 Control Rooms notifying that the Princess of Wales has been seen without an obvious escort. The caller should be thanked for the information but there is no need to take further action unless an accompanying incident is being notified.

Should an incident be notified a senior officer of SO14 Branch is to be contacted so that appropriate action may be taken. Out of office hours a senior officer of SO14 Branch is on call, and that officer should be advised of all incidents.

The senior officer may direct that a named SO14 PPO is to be contacted and directed to take certain action. A list of SO14 officers who are on call in respect of 'P 52' is shown on the PPO's weekly duties, a copy of which is kept in the Control Room, RPB.

Police Forces outside the MPD may report sightings or incidents, in which case the same directions will apply.

If any incident occurs within any of the Royal Palaces, a senior officer of SO15 Branch should be informed.

In any case of doubt the 'on call' senior officer of SO15 will be available to assist.

DAC MEYNELL has directed that TO 25 (CCC) will notify Control Room, RPB, of all incidents (but not sightings).
